### Day 1: Arrival in Nairobi (Sunday)

On arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi, Kenya's vibrant capital, a Kalama Safaris' representative will greet and transfer you to your hotel for check-in and relaxation.

Location: Nairobi

• Accommodation: Nairobi Serena Hotel (1 night)

• Meals: Meals (dependent upon arrival time)

• **Highlights**: City orientation

### Day 2: Flight to Arusha and Ngorongoro (Monday)

Fly to Arusha, Tanzania (about 1 hour). Transfer to the Ngorongoro Crater rim. Relax at the lodge with panoramic crater views. Formed approximately 2-3 million years ago when a massive volcano exploded and collapsed inward, the crater is often called the "Garden of Eden" due to its lush, self-contained ecosystem. The crater floor features diverse landscapes, including grasslands, swamps, forests, and Lake Magadi—a soda lake that attracts flamingos. It's part of the larger Ngorongoro Conservation Area, a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1979.

- Location: Arusha/Ngorongoro, Tanzania
- Accommodation: Ngorongoro Serena Lodge (1 night) rim-side luxury with crater vistas
- Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner
- Highlights: Crater rim views, introductory wildlife spotting, birdwatching

#### Day 3: Ngorongoro Crater to Ndutu (Tuesday)

Descend into Ngorongoro Crater for an early morning safari (about 5 hours), spotting up to 30,000 animals including lions, rhinos, elephants, and flamingos at Lake Magadi. Then drive to Ndutu (1-2 hours) and enjoy a late afternoon off-road game drive to get up-close and personal and view lions, cheetahs, elephants, birds, and other wildlife.

- Location: Ngorongoro Crater and Conservation Area (Ndutu)
- Accommodation: Ndutu Luxury Lodge (1 night)
- Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner
- **Highlights:** High-density Big Five in crater, off-road game drives

Days 4-5: Serengeti National Park (Wednesday-Thursday)

Morning game drive en route to Northern Serengeti (long drive, 4-6 hours). This area is a hotspot for the "Great Migration," with herds crossing rivers (July-November) or grazing year-round. Spot lions, leopards, elephants, and predators. Full days include morning and afternoon game drives.

- Location: Northern Serengeti
- Accommodation: Northern Serengeti Camp (2 nights) mobile luxury amid the plains
- **Meals**: Breakfast, lunch, dinner
- **Highlights**: Wildebeest and zebra herds, river crossings, Big Five encounters

Day 6: Flight to Masai Mara (Friday)

Fly to Masai Mara (about 1 hour) for game drives in the reserve, famous for migration river crossings, the Big Five, and abundant predators. As a key conservation area, Masai Mara is one of the Seven Natural Wonders of Africa supporting significant biodiversity.

- Location: Masai Mara National Reserve, Kenya
- Accommodation: Ilkeliani or Mara Serena Lodge (1 night) eco-friendly tents with river view
- Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner
- **Highlights:** Emerging migration herds, lion prides, balloon safaris with champagne breakfasts (extra fee ~\$500 per person) over the Masai Mara plains



Day 7: Masai Mara to Nairobi (Saturday)


After breakfast, fly back to Nairobi (45 minutes). Enjoy a farewell dinner. Use a day room to refresh and rest before airport transfer for your onward journey. Safe travel!

• Location: Masai Mara to Nairobi

• Accommodation: Four Points by Sheraton (day room, not overnight)

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner

Highlights: Last wildlife sightings

#### **Additional Notes**

- **Transportation:** Drives on most days; flights on Days 2, 6, and 7 via light aircraft. Border crossings require visas; Kalama Safaris provides information about visas.
- Inclusions: Accommodations, meals as noted, game drives, park fees, transfers. Extras like balloon rides (~\$500/person) optional.
